





# Name That Coin!

# Name That Coin!

## George Washington

### Quarter

- 1) He served as the first president of the United States.

- 4) He was the first person to sign the Constitution.
- 5) Even though he was the president, he never lived in the White House. It wasn't built yet!

## Thomas Jefferson

### Nickel

- 1) He served as the third president of the United States.
- 2) He authored the Declaration of Independence.
- 3) He spoke six languages, including French, Greek, Italian, Latin, and Spanish!
- 4) He had the largest personal collection of books (almost 6,500) in the United States at the time.
- 5) His face can be found among the figures of Mount Rushmore in South Dakota.

## Abraham Lincoln

### Penny

- 1) He was the 16th president of the United States, inaugurated in 1861.
- 2) His nickname is Honest Abe because he valued telling the truth.
- 3) He was president during the Civil War and is responsible for ending slavery.
- 4) President Lincoln had a good sense of humor and liked to tell jokes.
- 5) He is the tallest president in history, standing at 6 feet, 4 inches tall.

## Franklin D. Roosevelt

### Dime
